



Travel Tips to Keep Your Money *Safe!*

- **Keep one of your credit/debit cards and part of your currency separate from the rest.** In the event of loss or fraud, this will be your immediate back up.
- **Make photocopies** of your credit cards, debit cards, and passports that you are taking with you. Keep these copies in a separate, safe place while you travel. In the event of theft or loss, this information will help authorities and us to assist you promptly.
- **Load the United Equity CU App on your smartphone** to review accounts while traveling. You can also pay a bill with Picture Pay, deposit a check or make a loan payment all from the App.
- **Call the credit union to put a travel advisory on your VISA Credit and/or Debit Card.** Please provide the dates and where you will be traveling along with a phone number or email you can be reached at.
- **Use the Allpoint ATM App to locate surcharge free ATMs while traveling.**
- **The CO-OP Shared Branching App can help you find a shared branch location** if you need to access your account in person. You will need your government issued photo ID and account number.
- **Order your foreign currency at UECU before you travel to your foreign destination.** This can save you the hassle of locating a foreign currency exchange and paying high exchange rates.
- **Set up account alerts** through home banking sites for your accounts. This can be done for credit cards, too.
- **You can purchase a prepaid VISA Travel Debit Card from either UECU location.** The CU Travel Card can be reloaded until card expiration a couple of years away.
